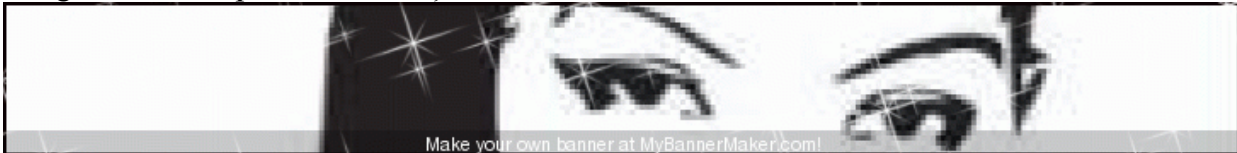


## Alana Sanders

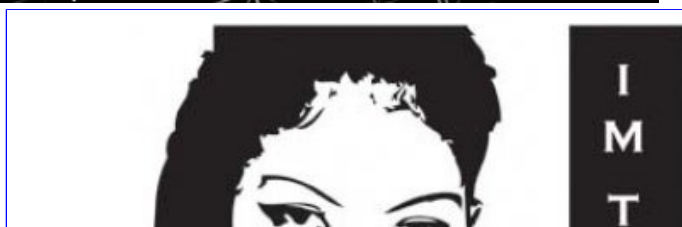
